 - Develop a question that invites critical thinking and personal interpretation.
 - This question should allow for a deeper exploration of themes, symbols, or character motivations in the chapter.
- **Review and Edit:**
 - Ensure that your quiz is free of errors and that the questions are clear and unbiased.
 - Check that your questions accurately reflect the content of Chapter 6.
