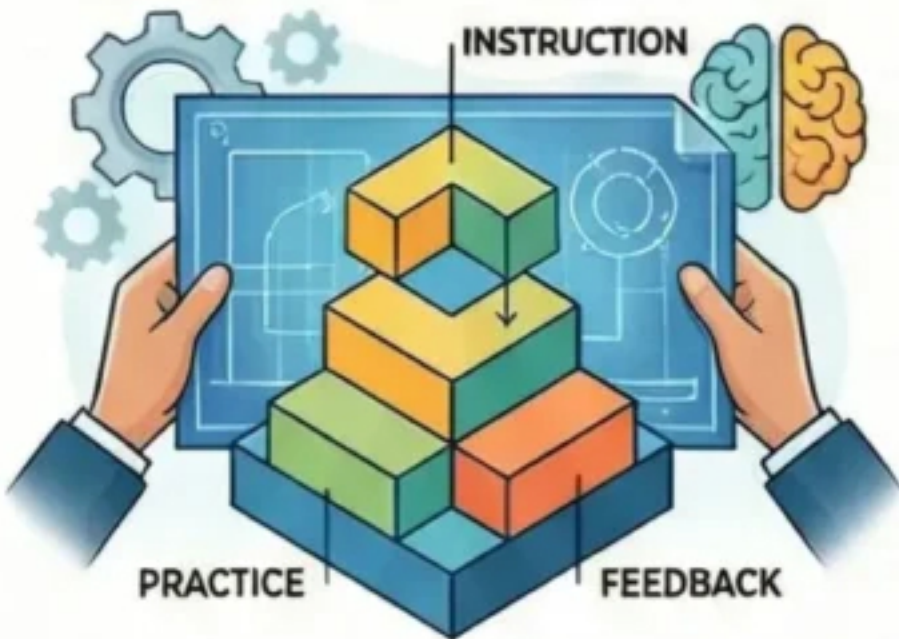


# Procedures as Curriculum: The 5-Lesson Blueprint for Classroom Management

Structured, instructional approach to teaching classroom routines as skills.

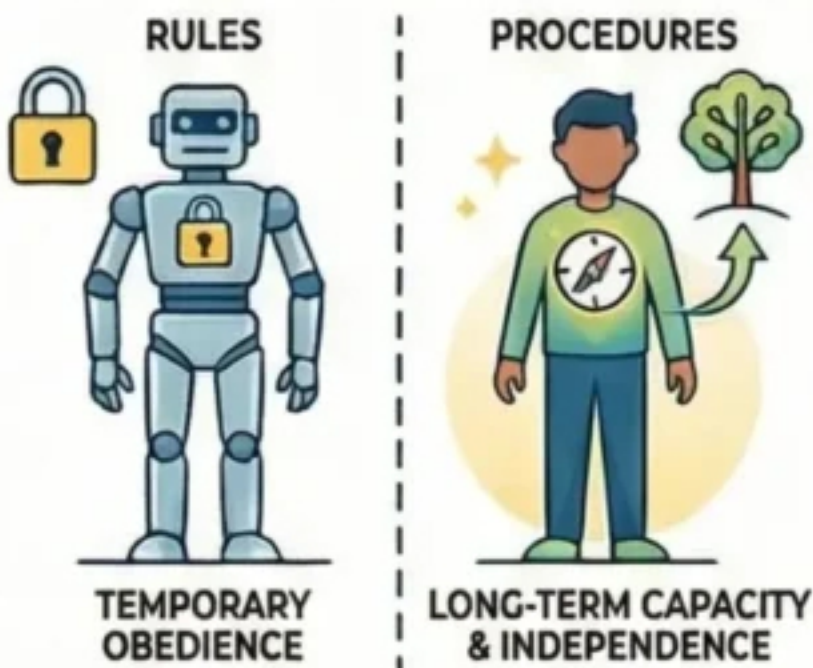
## SHIFTING THE MANAGEMENT MINDSET

Procedures are Skills, Not Rules



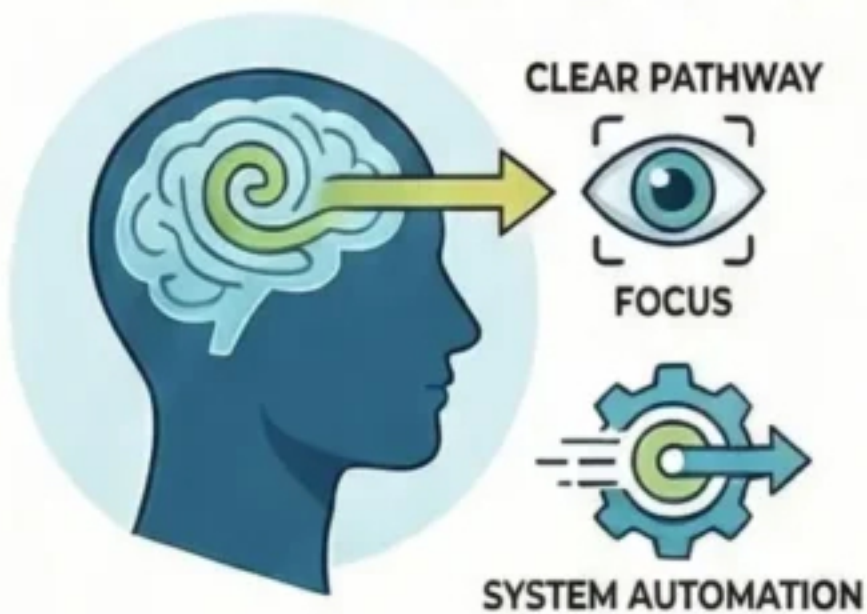
Treat routines like academic subjects that require instruction, practice, and feedback to master.

## Internalization vs. Compliance



Rules demand temporary obedience; taught procedures build long-term behavioral capacity and student independence.

## The "Thinking Load" Reduction



Clear procedures automate common tasks so students can focus their mental energy on learning.

## THE 5-LESSON INSTRUCTIONAL SEQUENCE

### LESSONS 1 & 2: BUILDING THE FOUNDATION



Lesson 1: Purpose - The "Why" (Explain how procedures help everyone learn). Lesson 2: Modeling - The "How" (Observe and name the specific steps).

### LESSONS 3 & 4: PRACTICE AND INDEPENDENCE



Lesson 3: Feedback - The Practice (Re-do steps until they match the model). Lesson 4: Independence - The Self-Check Perform and self-rate (Ready / Needs Work)

### LESSON 5: NORMALIZING THE RESET



Lesson 5: Repair - The Reset (Analyze a breakdown and suggest a fix).
